## **Colours of the Higgs Boson**

The exhibition "Colours of the Higgs Boson" comprises the works produced by the Milanese high school students involved in school-work project "Art & Science across Italy" of the CREATIONS network in the Horizon 2020 funding programme organized by the National Institute of Nuclear Physics and CERN.

The works produced by students will be on display together with those of CERN's art collection Art@CMS

inspired by the experiment taking place at the CERN Laboratory for Particle Physics.

The "Art & Science across Italy" project is divided into three phases: 1. training seminars and meetings in schools, INFN labs at the Milan university and guided tours of local art and science museums; 2. groups of three students create an artistic composition on one of the suggested scientific topics supported by INFN experts, the University and the Academy of Fine Arts; 3. students participate in an exhibition where their works are exhibited alongside those of the art collection ART@CMS.

Milan is the first exhibition location. The project also involves the cities of Naples, Florence, Padua and Venice, with a total of 107 classes and 2,980 students involved.

Friday, April 28 at 2.30 pm, the award ceremony of the six winning works of students from Milan will take place at the Museum. To participate in the event:
